

Frequently Asked Questions Related to Engagement of Guest/Part-Time Teachers

1. What is the Cut-off Date for determining the age limit and qualifications?

Answer: In **Column-4(iii)** of the Advertisement issued by the University it was clearly mentioned that Age, experience and all other prescribed qualifications would be counted as on 01.01.2021.

2. What is the criterion to assign marks for awards?

Answer: Marks would be assigned only for those awards which have been given either by (1) International Organisations/Government of India/Government of India recognized National Level Bodies, or (2) given by the State Government.

3. What is the criterion to assign marks for Post-Doctoral Fellowship?

Answer: As per decision of the meeting of all Deans in this regard:

(a) For Teachers in Active Service: The period of active service spent on PDF along with teaching without taking leave shall be awarded marks provided he/she have been duly appointed substantively against a permanent sanctioned post through commission or through a properly constituted Selection Committee as per concerned University Laws and approved by the Vice-chancellor.

(b) Such applicants who are not in active service shall not be awarded the benefit of PDF experience.

4. What is the criterion to assign marks for teaching experience?

Answer: Marks for teaching experience will be awarded only to those teachers who have been duly appointed substantively against a **permanent sanctioned post** through commission or through a properly constituted Selection Committee as per concerned University Laws and have the **approval of the Vice-chancellor**.

5. What is the criterion to assign marks for publications?

Answer: (A) Research papers published in journals with ISSN, and in books with ISBN shall be considered for awarding marks against publications, provided the

candidate has attached the page showing Date/Year of Publication, author's name, and at least the first page of the paper.

(B) Marks can be awarded on the basis of Certificate of Publication but not on the basis of Certificate of Acceptance.

6. What is the criterion to assign marks for NET/JRF?

Answer: To get marks for NET/JRF, copy of the certificate needs to be attached. No score will be awarded on the basis of NET/JRF marks-sheet.

6. At what stage reservation roster will be followed?

Answer: The current Reservation Policy of the Government of Bihar will strictly be followed category-wise and subject-wise, both at the time of selecting candidates to be called for interview (in case the total number of applicants in a particular subject exceed three times the total number of vacancies in that subject) and at the time of preparing panel for engagements. However, to get the benefit of reservation, claim for it must be made at the appropriate column of the application form; otherwise the benefit of reservation cannot be granted. The benefit of reservation is permissible only to the residents of Bihar, except *Divyang*.
